DAY 1 TRAVEL TO MAMMOTH LAKES

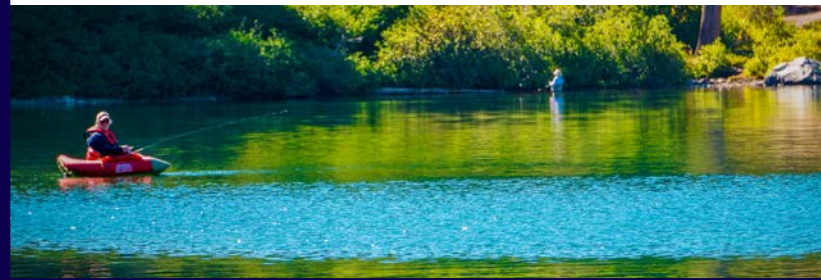
This travel day up in the Sierras includes a stop for a guided tour at Manzanar National Historic Site and WWII Japanese Internment Camp. Later, you'll check in to your charming hotel in Mammoth Lakes for a two night stay.

DAY 2 BODIE GHOST TOWN, JUNE LAKE AND MAMMOTH LAKES (B, D)

Continental breakfast is included at the hotel before traveling to Bodie State Historic Park, better known as Bodie Ghost Town. Bodie is a town frozen in time, and preserved by California State Parks in a state of "arrested decay." On the way back to Mammoth, we'll drive the June Lake Loop before returning with time on your own in Mammoth Lakes. Dinner is included at a popular local restaurant.

DAY 3 HOMEWARD BOUND (B)

After your continental breakfast, you'll depart the hotel and begin the journey home. Stops along the way at Schat's famous bakery in Bishop and the Museum of Western Film History.
